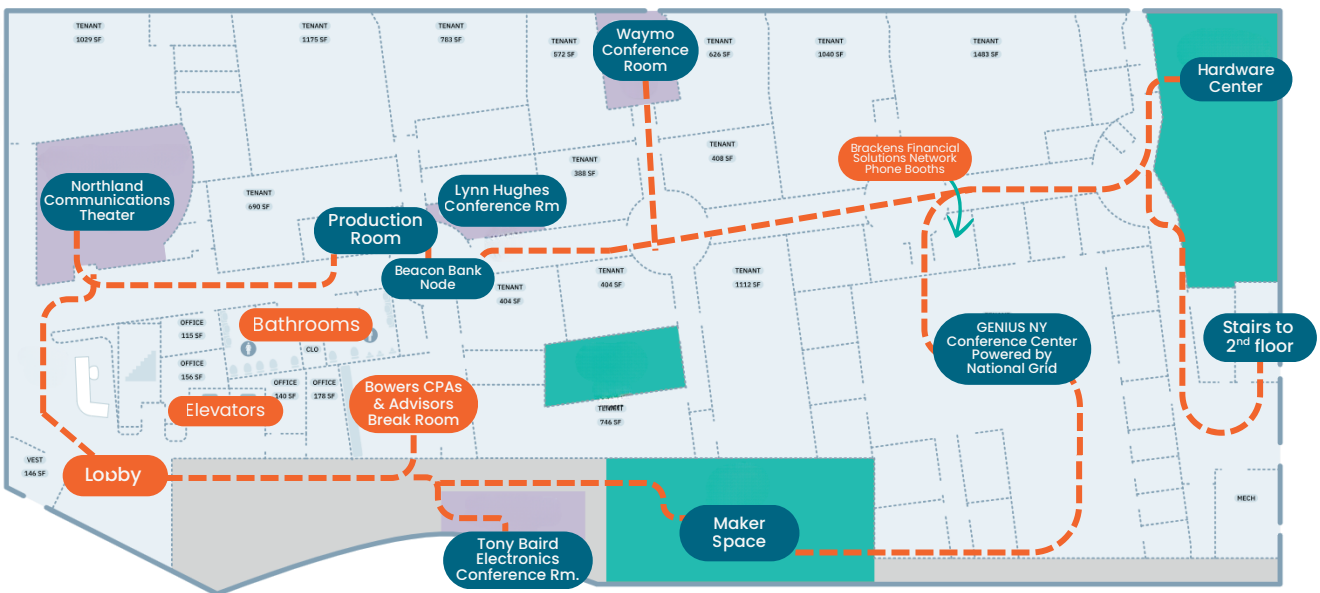


Day Pass Access

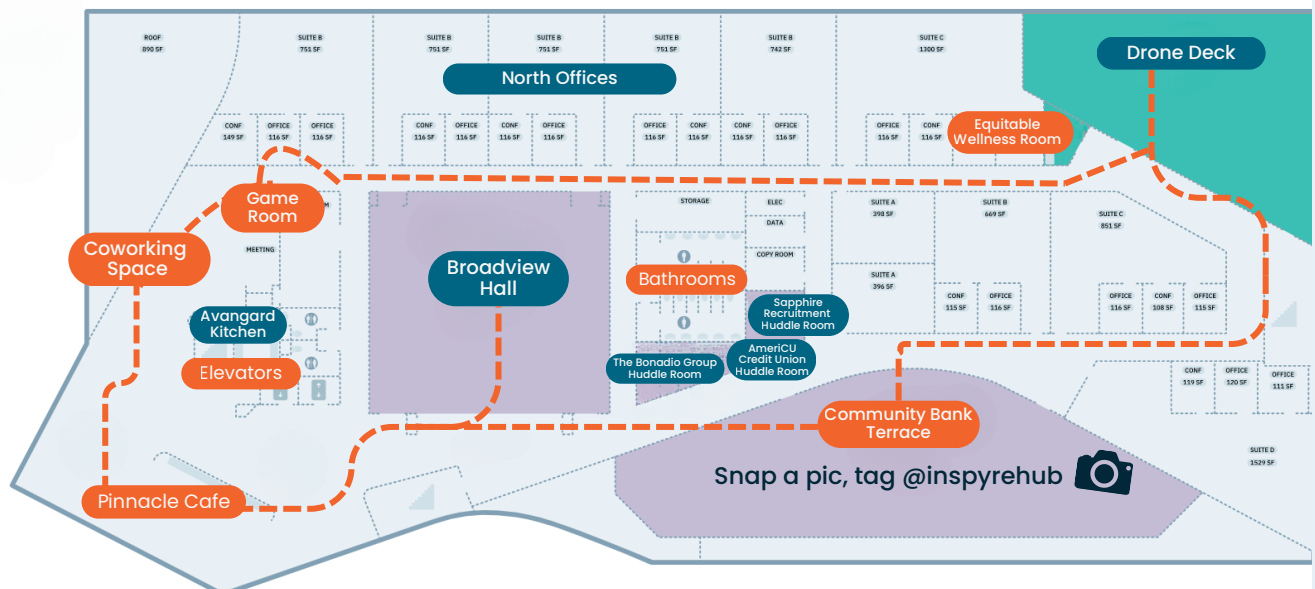


Restricted Access
